

Training courses from prosecutors to prosecutors

On May 24th and 28th 2021, two trainings courses took place online through the platform epresence.gov.gr. Two trained prosecutors trained a total of 40 public prosecutors about crimes with racist characteristics and motives. The trainings were based on the needs identified by previous projects, namely the project 'Building a Comprehensive Criminal Justice Response to Hate Crime', funded by the European Commission under ref. JUST/2015/RRAC/AG/ TRAI/9025 and implemented by the Office of Democratic Institutions and Human Rights (ODIHR) of OSCE and the Hellenic Ministry of Justice. ODIHR's training material that was used for the above-mentioned training (PAHCT) has been translated and customized for Greece, and was distributed to the prosecutors. The aim of the training course is that the prosecutors trained at that occasion will train other prosecutors (Training for Trainers), so that they are able to effectively investigate and prosecute hate crime and hate speech cases.
